Margaret Weese of Twp of Ameliasburgh in County of Prince Edward and Province of Canada, widow .....have..sold ..for 150 pounds..to Thomas McMurter of same place .. certain tract..in Ameliasburgh..containing 76 acres.. northeast half of Lot number 85 in First Concession of Twp opf Ameliasburgh..witness William Francis Weese and James Beard..Note that this parcel was bequeathed to Thomas' son in his 1882 will. Thomas appeared to only own land he purchased in or after 1853.

At the Registrar of the County of Prince Edward A Memorial to the Registrar  
 in the following words: "I Margaret Weese  
 of the Township of Ameliasburgh in the County of Prince Edward and Province of  
 Canada Widow for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty  
 pounds lawful money of the Province of Canada to me in hand paid  
 by Thomas McMurter of the same place, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
 knowledged have bargained sold assigned Quitted Claim and released  
 released and forever relinquished all my right of possession and all demand  
 both at Law and in equity and as well in expectancy as in possession to  
 all and singular those certain tracts or parcels of Land situate lying and  
 being in the Township of Ameliasburgh in the County of Prince Edward and  
 Province aforesaid containing by admeasurement Seventy six acres be the same  
 more or less being composed of the Northeast half of Lot number Eighty five  
 in the first Concession of the said Township of Ameliasburgh, To have and to hold  
 the above assigned premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to  
 him the said Thomas McMurter his heirs and assigns to their own use forever  
 which said Indenture is witnessed by William Francis Weese and James Beard  
 both of Ameliasburgh aforesaid in said County, And this Memorial thereof  
 is required to be Registered by me Thomas McMurter the grantee aforesaid  
 pursuant to Law. As Witness my hand and seal this Sixteenth day of April  
 A.D. 1853.
