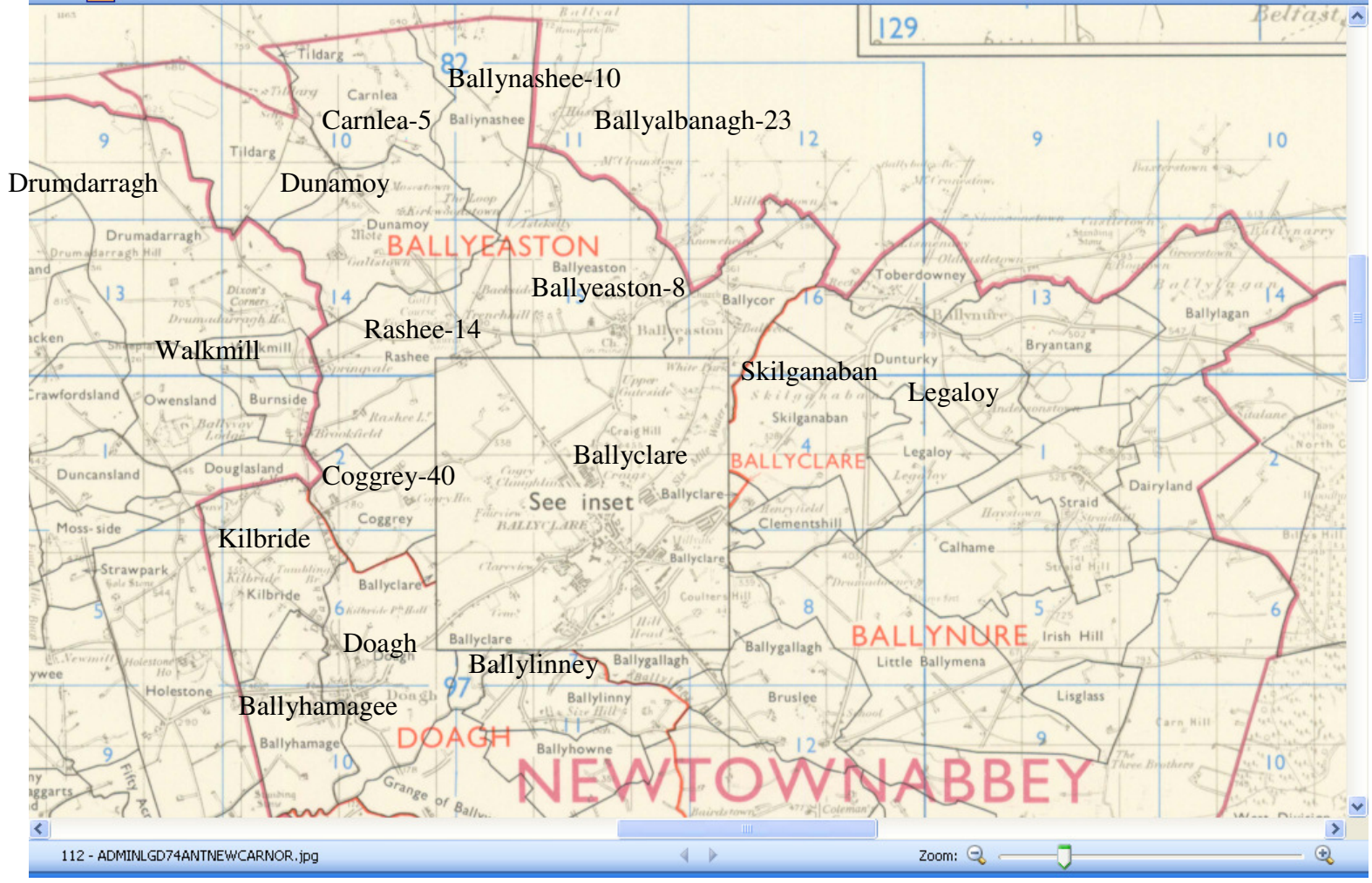


Map of the Area Served by the Ballyeaston Presbyterian Church and its Census of 1813 with focus on the Todd Family

If you take a look at the family charts for the census of 1813 and later records, you can get an idea of where these Todd families were in 1813 and where their children were born and married. The number beside the parish name is the number of Todds in that parish based on the church census. A large group of the Ballyalbanagh Todds went to Dearborn Co Indiana in 1829; one branch seems to be the branch that went to Saint Lawrence County, New York in 1850. Some of the Coggrey Todds may be the ancestors of a couple branches that went to Canada.



One family living in Co Antrim today matches the DNA of the Mary Todd Lincoln family and of two families that arrived in Canada about 1850. The family in Ireland is descended from a William Todd b 1799/1800 who may be from Carnlea since he lived in Dunamoy 1825 and Drumdarragh 1830.
