

Robert R. Preston Todd b 1814-7 in VA married a granddaughter of Andrew Todd. The DNA of descendants of two different sons of Preston Todd matched the Horton family of Russell Co VA. This map shows the geographic relationships between the lands of the Todds and the Hortons.

Lavisa Fork of Sandy River where lived Abner Vance who killed Daniel Horton's brother.

It is about 10 miles from Horton Valley to Maiden Spring and perhaps 12 miles to Lavisa Fork.

Andrew Todd's land sales in 1800 were for a parcel at the "point of Paint Lick Mountain" north of James Brown (probably just to the NE of the town of Liberty) and a parcel in southeast of Maiden Spring (possibly Gillespies) south of James Browns 400 acre parcel

George Todd's 1822 sale of 100 acres to Thomas Brooks mentions spur pf Morris Knob and neighbors Daniel Young and Issac Moore who owned several parcels "south side of Morris Knob".
