1. Introduction to the Todds .

The Todds of Brawleys and Carsons Fork, Rutherford/Cannon County TN

The lineages that follow are for one of the three families of Todds who settled in Rutherford and Cannon Co Tennessee in the early 1800s.

These lineages are part of a larger work that chronicles the history of all three Todd families - one from England, one probably from Northern Ireland and the other of unknown origin - who all migrated to America and in their westward migrations, crossed paths in Rutherford and Cannon County Tennessee in the early 1800s. Over the decades, two of those families intertwined and intermarried such that the descendants no longer knew that their ancestors were from two different families.

The advent of DNA analysis in family history has enabled us to separate out the three families and show relationships within the two families that were not known until now.

The three families were:

Edmond Todd b 1786 North Carolina who settled 12 miles north of

Murfreesboro about 1811. His daughter Elizabeth married James Henderson Baldridge and had a son Edmund Todd Baldridge. The Baldridges intermarried with the Gregory family in Crockett Co TN. The DNA from a descendant of Edmond Todd did not closely match any of the other Todds in Rutherford Co, but he may have kinship through one of his ancestral lines, other than the Todds or through kinship before the family came to TN..

Joseph Todd of Eling:

Joseph Todd was born about 1645 in the village of Eling in Southamptonshire, along the southern coast of England. In 1698, he brought his family to America settling in Philadelphia, but never got to enjoy the fruits of his migration because he and his wife died shortly after their arrival. Three of his grandchildren migrated to Northampton County in northeastern Pennsylvania and then, just before the Revolution, migrated to Rowan County North Carolina. After a generation in NC, branches of the family made their way to Madison County, Kentucky between 1795 and 1803. In 1809, several branches moved south to Rutherford County Tennessee, settling in the Big Springs area, southeast of Murfreesboro.

Todds of Brawleys and Carons Fork

Three brothers (Jesse Todd b 1770-80, James B. Todd b 1788, and William T. Todd b 1793) were in North Carolina in the 1780s and 1790s. By 1806, Jesse Todd was in Wilson Co Tennessee and by 1811, all three were in Rutherford County where Jesse bought land in 1814 and William married in 1815. They had a sister Jemima Todd who married in 1821 to Hugh Brawley, the son of the Hugh Brawley who built one of the first mills in the area and who was the source of stream name, Brawley's Fork.

During 2011, DNA analysis and research into original county records revealed some of the secrets in both families' origins and relationships. This book integrates these new discoveries into the family history reported by previous family historians.

Early family historians of the Todds of Rutherford/Cannon County TN were convinced that all the Todds in those early years were from the same family. Hence, they guessed at some of the relationships. For example, they thought that James B. Todd b 1788 NC and William T. Todd b 1793 NC were sons of Benjamin Todd b 1759 of Rutherford County and that Jesse Todd b 1770-80 was son of Joseph Todd b 1748 who lived in Madison County KY and was a cousin of Benjamin Todd b 1759. But deed records in Madison County revealed that Jesse Todd of Rutherford/Cannon Co was not the son of Joseph b 1748 and male DNA testing showed that Jesse, James B. and William were brothers to each other and not descended from a male Todd of the family of Benjamin Todd b 1759.

Walker Todd b 1822 came to Cannon Co in 1847 and Jefferson Todd b 1817 came to Cannon Co by 1848. They settled on the lands of or near James B Todd. Over the decades, their descendants intermarried and forgot their separate origins.

I hope that you readers enjoy learning a bit about your ancestors!

2. Father Todd

Sometime between 1806 and 1810, four members of a North Carolina Todd family - Jesse b 1770-80, James B. b1788, William T. b 1793, and Jemima came to the portion of Rutherford County, TN that became Cannon County in 1836.

The parents of the four Todds who lived in Cannon County lived originally in North Carolina between 1788 and 1793 when James B and William T. Todd were born. The father should appear in the 1790 census with two sons under 16 - James B. b 1788 and Jesse b 1776-1780. There is a John Todd in Onslow Co NC who fits that criteria , but no research has as yet been done in Onslow County to see if a link exists there. Some of the Todds in Bertie County have been sampled, but there many be several different families in Bertie County and so more research has to be done there. Also the Todds of Bute (later Franklin and Warren Co) have not been studied.

The family may have had a Scotch-Irish origin because a family with matching DNA pattern has been found in Co Derry in Northern Ireland, though the family by the 1800s was a Catholic family.

James B., William T. and Jesse all had the same male DNA pattern and their ages suggest they are brothers. Their DNA pattern differs from the DNA pattern of the family of Benjamin Todd b 1759 the Revolutionary War soldier who came to Rutherford Co from Madison Co KY in 1809. It seems as if

these two unrelated Todd families crossed paths in the Rutherford/Cannon Co area, intermarried, and forgot they had different origins. It is possible their paths crossed in NC since the DNA suggests a connection of some sort further back in the 1700s, possibly via their spouses.

Jemima Todd who married Hugh Brawley in 1821 in Rutherford County is probably a sister to the brothers of this family. Hugh Brawley got a land grant in 1815 on Owl Creek next door to the land Jesse Todd bought in 1814. She could have been Jesse's daughter but more likely a sister given her marriage date of 1821 and Jesse's birth about 1780 and birth's of Jesse's children in the 1810s.

There are three Brawley descendants (Mary Margaret, Nancy and Hugh) whose DNA suggests they were siblings and possibly could be children of Jemima Todd and Hugh Brawley. However, there is not a totally consistent pattern with the DNA; so we can not be sure.

I include this discussion in this introduction because it helps give some context to the confusing relationships between the Todds of the area.

Father had the following children:

3M i. **Jesse Todd** was born in 1776/1780. He died after 1840.

4M ii. **James B. Todd Sr.** was born in 1788. He died in 1860/1870.

5M iii. **William Thomas Todd** was born on 28 Sep 1793. He died in 1860/1870.

6F iv. **Jemima Todd** was born about 1790/1800. She died after 1830.

Third Generation

3.Jesse Todd (Father Todd, Introduction to the) was born in 1776/1780 in Rowan County, North Carolina, USA. He died after 1840 in Tennessee or Missouri, USA.

Jesse Todd was born 1770-1780, probably in North Carolina. Based on DNA evidence, he was close kin to James B. Todd and William T. Todd and shared the same male ancestor. Based on his age, he was probably their brother. This is a big change from previous understandings of family historians who believed he was the son of Joseph Todd b 1748 of Madison Co KY.

He came to Tennessee by 1806 (while the Big Springs Todds were still in Kentucky) when he appeared on a tax list in Wilson Co just to the north of Rutherford County.. He married and started a family about this time. Then he came and settled in Rutherford County. In 1814, William Nash sold him 86 acres on Owl Creek, a small branch of Carson's Creek not far from the confluence of Carson's Creek with Stones River. In 1820, he was one of the two executors of the estate of Jesse Patrick along with a son-in-law of Jesse, Joshua Vasser b 1773 NC. Jesse Patrick's widow Jemimiah/Gemima Patric was living with Jesse Todd's brother William in the 1850 census. Gemima Patrick also sold in 1847 to Micajah Todd , son of Jesse, land inherited from her husband.

He also got a land grant in the same area in 1825. These lands were adjacent to Hugh Brawley, Mary Meredith and Cornelius Brandon. In 1825, Mary Meredith sold him 50 acres on Dry Creek of the East Fork of Stones River in the portion of Rutherford County that became Cannon Co in 1836. In 1835, Jesse purchased 200 acres on Brawley's Fork.

Jesse appears on the 1820 Rutherford County Census with at least six children: three boys born between 1804 and 1820, and a girl born 1810-1820. There was also a male 18-26 (born 1794-1802) and a female 16-26 (born 1794-1804) and a female, presumably his wife, 26-45 (born 1775-1794).

In 1837, Jesse sold his 40 acres on Brawley's Fork to Jacob Falkenberry and sold his Owl Creek land to David Faulkenberry.

The male DNA shows that Jesse was definitely part of the James B. and William T. Todd family not the family of Benjamin Todd b 1759 or his Madison Co KY kin. The Todds in Onslow and Bertie County need to be more thoroughly studied to see if there is a link with those families.

Jesse previously had been identified as the son of Joseph Todd b 1748 of Madison Co KY. However, an 1812 deed listing all the heirs of Joseph Todd b 1748 indicated that Joseph's son Jesse was still a minor and therefore born after 1791. So Jesse of Rutherford County could not be the Jesse, son of Joseph. The only other Jesse Todd in Madison Co KY was the son of Peter

Todd b 1756 who was born about 1792.

Jesse sold his lands in the late 1830s. Though he appears on the 1840 census, we do not find him in 1850.

In 1820, Jesse Todd and Joshua Vassar were named the executors of the will of Jesse Patrick. The widow of Jesse Patrick was Jemima/Gemima Patrick b Virginia 1763 who in 1850 was living with Jesse's brother William Todd. In 1850, Joshua Vassar was living next door to Milton Todd, son of James B. Todd.

Joshua Vasser was said to have come from Sumter Co SC though he was born in NC in 1773. Some report that Joshua's father Daniel Vasser was born in Amelia Co VA. in 1789. However, this may be a confusion of two different Joshua Vasser's. Though he was identified as a son-in-law to Jesse Patrick, Jesse Todd the other coadministrator of Jesse Patrick's estate, was not so identified. Because of Gemima Patrick living with William Todd in 1850, we suspect that Gemima was sister to one of the parents of the Todds. There were many Vassars in Northampton Co NC in 1790; there was a Todd family of unknown fate in Bute Co (later Warren and Franklin County) that was near Northampton Co. This might be another clue to the origins of the Cannon County Todds.

There is a Jesse Patrick in Orangeburg, SC in 1820.

A land grant mentions Jesse Todd as a neighbor to Hugh Brawley.

Because of this proximity of residence, we thought that the Jemima Todd who married Hugh Brawley in 1821 in Rutherford Co might be the father of Mary Margaret Brawley who married 1843 to David H Phillips and Nancy Brawley who married 1842 to William C. Givens/Gibbens and Hugh Brawley b 1823.

Family Finder DNA had contradictory results as to whether Jesse Todd was the uncle of the Brawley girls to strongly confirm the Brawley girls connection to Hugh Brawley and Jemima Todd, but the proximity of Hugh Brawley and Jesse Todd suggest Jesse was the brother of Jemima Todd. More DNA tests are needed to resolve this.

Gemima/Jemima Patrick born 1763 Virginia was closely associated with this group of Todds, suggesting she might have been kin to their mother. She deeded her dower land to one of the children of Jesse Todd.

Jesse married **Unknown Todd**.

They had the following children:

7M i. **James P. Todd** was born in 1813.

8M ii. **Micajah Franklin Todd** was born about 1817.

Jesse married **Nancy Russell** on 24 Sep 1836 in Rutherford County, Tennessee, USA.

4. **James B. Todd Sr.** (Father Todd, Introduction to the) was born in 1788 in Rowan County, North Carolina, USA. He died in 1860/1870 in Cannon County, Tennessee, USA.

James B. Todd was born in 1788 in North Carolina and spent his early boyhood there. Since his brother Jesse was on the 1806 tax list of Wilson Co

TN when James was 18 and brother William T. was only 13, it would appear that the father had died and the rest of the family had migrated to TN by that time. By 1811, he was on the tax lists in Rutherford Co as James B. Todd. About this time, he married and began his family, with Thomas Lawson Todd

being estimated to have been born 1810-1811.

He bought land in 1831 from Jonathan Bateman and got a grant that same year for 100 acres on Horse Spring Branch (probably the present day Haws Spring Branch, a tributary of Carson's Fork near the town of Burt. He lived in the portion of Rutherford County that became Cannon Co in 1836.

He died between 1860 and 1870.

Notes and Documentation:

James B. Todd b 1788 NC was considered for many years to be a son of Benjamin Todd b 1759, but male DNA evidence showed that James B. Todd was a brother to William Thomas Todd and Jesse Todd, but that none of them shared a male Todd ancestor with the other Rutherford Co Todds. Since their DNA matched a family from Co Londonderry Ireland, it is thought that the brothers were from an unrelated family. It is nevertheless possible that there was a common ancestor through the wives of the three Todd brothers.

Research in NC is needed to find the family of origin of this James B. Todd and his brother William Thomas Todd. There is a John Todd in Onslow Co NC who has 2 sons under 16 in the 1790 census.

Glenda Dobbs reported that Norma Todd Cansler wrote that she (Norma) has the death certificate of James Barkley Todd and considered that a part of the circumstantial evidence to place James B Todd as the son of Benjamin Todd and Margaret Barkley. However, male DNA shows that James B. was not a son of Benjamin Todd and Margaret Barkley or any other male Todd kin to Benjamin Todd.

1840 Cannon County Census has 2M 5/10, 1M 10/15, 2M 15/20, 1M 20/30 1M50/60, 1F U 5, 1F 15/20, and 1F 40/50. 1850 Cannon County Census has James Todd 62, Jane 56, David 29, Ransom 21, Granville 18, Tolbert F15, Ellsabeth J 13, Sarah 10, and Nancy 8. 1860 Cannon County Census has Jas Todd 72, Retired Farmer b. NC, Jane 65 b. VA, Sarah Todd 19 b. TN, and Puss Todd 15 (Mulatto) b. TN.

James married **Jane Unknown**. Jane was born in 1794/1796 in Virginia, USA. She died about 1880 in Cannon County, Tennessee, USA.

5. **William Thomas Todd** (Father Todd, Introduction to the) was born on 28 Sep 1793 in NC. He died in 1860/1870 in Cannon County, TN.

William Thomas Todd was born in North Carolina on 28 September 1793 according to a family bible passed down in his family. He married in Rutherford Co to Margaret Spear on Oct 15, 1815.

He got a land grant in the 1830s for over 500 acres that stretched from Horse Spring Creek (probably the creek known now as Haws Spring Creek, a branch of Carson's Fork near the town of Burt) to Dry Creek in Warren County almost 2 miles to the east.

He and Margaret had 11 children between 1817 and 1839.

He died as did his brother James between 1860 and 1870.

IN 1850, Jemima Patric/Patrick b 1763 VA was living with William Todd. In 1847, she had conveyed land inherited from her husband Jesse Patrick to one

of Jesse Todd's children. She would have been 17 in 1780 when Jesse was born; so it is conceivable she was the mother of the Todd brothers.

Jesse Patrick died in 1820 and Jesse Todd and Joshua Vasser were the executors of the will. Joshua Vasser was identified as a son-in-law, but Jesse was not.

DB F 151. On 5 Nov 1847 Jemima Patrick conveyed to Micajah F. Todd a tract in Civil District 4, but formerly Rutherford County, containing 30 acres. Dower willed to me by Jesse Patrick, deceased. Witnesses: Martin Cox, Ambers Petty.

Joshua Vasser lived in 1850 next to Milton Todd, son of James B. Todd.

Jesse Patrick of Cannon County TN, (Warren and other Counties TN until 1836), was orphaned at the age of 7 years and that his father was Levi Patrick (Cannon County Court Minutes 1837).

Jemimah Patrick was in the 1820 census in Rutherford Co on the same page as William and James Todd, a woman living alone, over 45, and therefore is the Gemima Patrick, the widow of Jesse Patrick. There were Patricks in the Nashville area.

William married **Margaret Spear** on 15 Oct 1815 in Rutherford Co TN. Margaret was born on 7 Sep 1796 in Rutherford Co., Tennessee. She died in 1860/1870 in Cannon County, TN.

They had the following children:

Rutherford County, TN Will BK 1/456: I, James S Todd, do make and publish this as my Last Will and Testament. First, I direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts be paid as soon aft my death as possible, out of any moneys that I may die possessed of, or may first cause into the hands of my executors. Secondly, I give and bequeath to wife, M E Todd, one hundred and fifty dollars out of my personal effects and I give to her my

farm, where I am now living, her maternal life and at her death, said land is to be sold and the proceeds divided equally between my children, except John T Todd, my eldest child, he having received his part. I will to him, one dollar. Lastly, I do appoint my wife, M E Todd, and my son, L F Todd, to wind up my estate and

to carry out this my will. This 21st day of May 1898, James S (x mark) Todd. Attest: J A McKnight and W A McKee. Probated Feb 1899.

James married **Jemima Cox** on 18 Oct 1846 in Cannon Co TN. Jemima was born about 1828.

6. Jemima Todd (Father Todd, Introduction to the) was born about 1790/1800. She died after 1830 in Shelby Co IL or Rutherford Co TN.

Jemima Todd married Hugh Brawley in 1821. Hugh was the son of Hugh Brawley, the founder of Brawley's mill, who died in 1811.

Hugh Brawley was an adjacent property owner to Jesse Todd b 1770-80, having gotten a grant on Owl Creek in 1814/1815.

Hugh and Jemima reportedly went to Shelby Co IL where they appear on the 1830 census.

Some historians belief that the children of Hugh and Jemima were orphaned and returned to Rutherford/Warren Co and married in Rutherford Co in the 1840s.

Mary Margaret Brawley b 1826 married 1843 to David Phillips
Nancy Brawley 28 Dec 1823 married 1842 William C. Givens/Gibbons
Sarah Brawley married 1843 Samuel R. Phillips
Hugh Brawley b 1823 married Martha Malone

DNA suggests the possibility that Nancy and Mary Margaret and Hugh were siblings but do not support the conclusion that they were children of Jemima Todd, assuming she was a sister of the Jesse, James B and William T. Nevertheless, they seem to be related to Jesse Todd and James B. Todd, but at too great a distance for Jemima Todd to have been a sister. It was as if she were a cousin of Jesse and James B. More samples in the Brawley family and in the Jesse, James B. and William T. families are needed to confirm or refute these conclusions.

Jemima married **Hugh Brawley** in 1821 in Rutherford Co TN. Hugh was born in 1799. He died after 1830 in Shelby Co IL or Rutherford Co TN.
