

## Todd Families in Putnam & Jones Co GA 1820s/1830s

The Red Boxes are the lands of the family of Benjamin Todd 1778-1855, including parcels he bought in 1812, 1817, 1821, 1823 and parcels of his sons John and William and son-in-laws Thomas Vincent and Richmond Buckner.

The blue boxes are lands that have relationship to John Todd b 1770-80; 169 being the lot 169, bought in 1816; Lot 226 being near Lorena Leggitt's home, his daughter-in-law. Lot 148 where he witnessed a deed in 1821. The blue dots/circles are John's neighbors in the 1820 census
