
Todds in Armagh Parishes in Tithe Applotment Books (6) and Griffith's Survey (6) The Todds were concentrated in the N and NE end of Armagh. In 1820/1830, 40% of the Todds are in Drumcree and by 1860s, a little over half were there. In 1820/1830, 80% of the Todds are in the cluster of NE parishes of Drumcree, Tartaraghan, Loughall, Grange, Mullaghbrack, Seagoe. In the 1860s, about 70% lived there.
